

Fieldwork Opportunity at University of Redlands

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Description of Internship (duties and responsibilities):

We are seeking an experienced teacher or innovative teacher in training to support undergraduate students who are developing and facilitating innovative workshops for incarcerated youth in San Bernardino. Depending on time and availability, Intern would meet bi-weekly with 5-6 student teams to discuss facilitation struggles and curriculum planning, would provide written feedback on weekly lesson plans to improve curriculum, would meet with supervisor to solve problems and develop plans for ongoing training and student support, if the intern can commit to working for the rest of the year and is available Fridays, they could also observe lesson plans on Fridays from 9-11:30 and 12:30-1:30 (but this would require getting cleared and trained by Probation to be able to enter the facility).

Intern Qualifications:

Experience, training and/or interest in curriculum development, experience and commitment to critical pedagogy, ability to support and lead novice teachers in scaffolding engaging discussions and critical thinking among young people with negative experiences with traditional education.
