## **CULMINATING EXPERIENCES AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

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### **Application for Graduation**

Students who have completed all program requirements should contact their advisor to request a sign-off.

### **Commencement**

School of Education students complete program requirements at various points throughout the year. Students may apply to commence in the academic year in which they complete their program requirements as long as they do so by August 31. An application must include a reasonable plan for completing the remaining credits by August 31 and should be submitted to the student's advisor by January 31. Doctoral candidates must successfully defend their dissertation by the last day of the 11th week of the spring term in order to be eligible for participation in commencement.
