Currency must be converted to U.S. dollars (see www.federalreserve.gov/releases/h10/current to review daily exchange rates or use a currency converter such as the one at www.oanda.com/currency/converter/). If the fiscal year does not end in December 2016, we need a signed copy of your most recently filed tax return along with a letter from your employer or accountant stating your January 2016 through December 2016 earnings.

Note: Parents who did not file a 2016 IRS Tax Return must provide documentation from the IRS or other relevant Tax Authority dated on or after October 1, 2017 that indicates a 2016 IRS income return was not filed with the IRS or relevant tax authority. This can be obtained by clicking "Get a tax transcript ONLINE" at https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript or by completing the 4506T request form, which you can find at www.irs.gov/form4506t.
