CULMINATING EXPERIENCES AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Transfer Credit

Program requirements may be met in part by transfer credit. A maximum of 24 units may be transferred with advisor approval, speak to an advisor for more information. No courses that have been completed more than six years before the anticipated date of graduation shall be counted toward a graduate degree and cannot be transferred.

Fieldwork Experiences

Students must complete 400 of their required 600 hours in two different K-12 settings, one must be a public high school (California state requirement for the PPS Credential).

Students will work with their advisor to identify fieldwork placement

Culminating Experiences

Students must pass the CPCE.

Credential Recommendation

Students who have completed all program requirements should contact their advisor to be recommended to the State for a credential.

Commencement

School of Education students complete program requirements at various points throughout the year. Students may apply to commence in the academic year in which they complete their program requirements as long as they do so by August 31.

Application for Graduation

Students who have completed all program requirements should contact the Fieldwork and Advising Office to request a degree sign off and a credential recommendation.
