Director's Monthly Update



As we near the end of our spring term and inch closer to summer, we are getting even more excited about the future of SCS. Our summer term enrollments are strong and our new programs are getting off the ground. We hope that all of you, no matter your status at the university, will you take the opportunity to look through our website to see what courses may be of interest to you. We have twenty courses starting in June, including Marketing, Child Development, Human Rights and Global Advocacy, History, Nonprofit Management, and Introduction to Communicative Disorders. Some of the most prominent U of R professors are teaching courses that are open to all. Dr. Julius Bailey, a leading religion scholar, for example, is teaching American Religious History which is an exploration of religion in America from the pre-colonial era to the present. In this fascinating

course, he will cover religious communities such as Puritan, Native American, Muslim, Buddhist, African American, Hindu, Evangelical, Catholic, and Neo-Pagan. He will also introduce religious issues such as civil rights, new religious movements or "cults," church/state, gender, race, and ethnicity. We are also lucky enough to have Anna Gaitan teaching Drawing, which focuses on traditional techniques, materials, and processes of drawing. Primary focus will be placed on composition, mark-making, perspective, and interpretative drawing. This course would be great for experienced and beginner artists!
