

Summer Housing

Residence Life and Housing

Summer Housing has limited capacity, so students are advised to explore a variety of options for their housing needs as of Friday, May 27th at 2pm when the communities will close for the summer. Read below for further information about housing placement priority.

University Policies:

Students are responsible for reading and understanding all details of the [Room and Board Contract](#) and [Code of Community Standards](#) before continuing. Please review these thoroughly, as completing this application indicates a student will uphold all information included in the publications and information included below.

Summer Housing Criteria, Location, and Cost:

- Summer Housing priority is first given to students who are employed on-campus through Student Employment. These are most often students working with Facilities Management, Event Services, and/or completing summer research.
 - All other applicants are on a waiting list on a first come, first serve basis, based on the remaining availability of spaces.
- The location of summer housing is Holt Hall with double occupancy rooms.
 - Single occupancy rooms will only be provided to students with a single room [accommodation](#) with Academic Success and Disability Services (ASDS).
- The rate for Summer Housing is \$100 per week, billed as a term for 13 weeks. Arrangements for shorter, prorated stays may be made on an individual basis with Residence Life and Housing.

Summer Housing Scheduled Dates and Times:

- Residents approved for Summer Housing will check-in to their new room location on Wednesday, June 1st between 3-5pm.
- Residents living on-campus in the fall semester will move into their fall housing assignments on Sunday, August 14th between 8:00-10:00am.
- Residents going abroad, living off campus for Fall 2022, or those who have graduated in the spring must make other housing arrangements and vacate campus housing Sunday, August 14th by 2pm.
 - These persons may continue to work their summer student employee position as permitted by Student Employment.

Consider Before Applying:

- Although the communities will close on Friday, May 27th at 2pm, residents approved for Summer Housing will remain in their rooms until their new space is available on Wednesday, June 1st between 3-5pm.
- It is the responsibility of each resident to read, understand, and adhere to the law and all campus policies, including the [Room and Board Contract](#) and [Code of Community Standards](#). Living on campus while classes are in session supports students in the completion of their degree, while other times of the year, such as Early Arrivals, Winter Break, May Break, and during the summer, residents live on campus for other reasons. Those reasons include (but are not limited to) student employment and continued participation in athletics. **Residents should recognize that living in campus housing outside regular academic semesters is a privilege. Because of this, any violations of the law or campus policy that occur during these times will likely result in the removal from housing and can result in losing the privilege of such housing in perpetuity.**
