DR. MARY VIXIE SANDY

Executive Director California Commission on Teacher Credentialing

Mary Vixie Sandy is the Executive Director of the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing, the nation's oldest independent standards board for educators. She oversees policy related to educator preparation and licensing, leading an agency that issues over 300,000 credentials annually and accredits more than 250 institutions offering educator preparation programs.

Previously, Dr. Vixie Sandy served as Executive Director of the UC Davis School of Education Center for Cooperative Research and Education Services for Schools, Associate Director of Teacher Education and Public School Programs at the CSU Chancellor's Office, and policy analyst for the California Department of Education and the California Postsecondary Education Commission.

A San Francisco native, she holds a Doctorate in Leadership for Education Equity from UC Berkeley, a Master's in Philosophy in Education from UC Davis, and a Bachelor's in Philosophy from Sonoma State University. Recipient of the 2022 James A. Kelley Award, her work centers on strengthening teacher and school capacity to serve California's diverse students.
