Official Declaration of Sources of Funds and Assured Support

REQUIREMENTS

United States universities are required by law to verify that students entering the U.S. have adequate financial resources to meet the expenses of the first year of their studies. Before we are authorized to send you the I-20 (Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status) form needed to apply for your student visa, you must complete all parts of the Certificate of Finances.

All signatures and documentation provided must be less than six months old. Support may come from any combination of sources, including personal, family, scholarships, or sponsored funds. You must provide documentation for each source of funding. Your available funds must be equal or greater to the amounts listed below.
