

## Cal Poly Pomona: A Short History

Cal Poly Pomona is one of the two polytechnic universities in the 23-campus California State University system, with about 24,000 students and 2,600 faculty and staff. It opened in 1938 as the Voorhis Unit of California State Polytechnic College in San Luis Obispo on part of the 813 acre ranch that cereal magnate W.K. Kellogg donated to the state of California to use as a public university.

One of Kellogg's conditions was that the University care for his horse herd in perpetuity. The University's W.K. Arabian Horse Center is responsive to that condition.

## Directions to the Cal Poly Campus



### From Los Angeles:

Take the 10 freeway EAST and exit at Kellogg Drive. The ramp will transition on to Kellogg Drive. Proceed to Parking Structure 2 and then on to the Bronco Student Center per the map on the next page.

### From Orange County:

Take the 57 freeway NORTH to Temple Avenue and exit north (left-hand turn) to the campus. Temple will go down the hill. Stay on Temple until the large electronic marquee that welcomes visitors at South Campus Drive. Turn right on South Campus Drive. Turn left on Kellogg Drive and proceed to Parking Structure 2 and then on to the Bronco Student Center per the map on the next page .

### From The Inland Empire

Take the 10 freeway WEST and exit at Kellogg Drive. Stay in your left lane, you should be on the left side of the large electronic marquee that welcomes visitors. Turn right onto Palm Drive and stay on the right side to turn right on Oak Lane and proceed to Parking Structure 2 and then on to the Bronco Student Center per the map on the next page

### From the Pasadena area:

Take the 210 freeway EAST to 57 Freeway SOUTH. Exit on Temple Avenue and turn north (right-hand turn) to the campus. Temple will go down the hill. Stay on Temple until the large electronic marquee that welcomes visitors at South Campus Drive. Turn right on South Campus Drive. Turn left on Kellogg Drive and proceed to Parking Structure 2 and then on to the Bronco Student Center per the map on the next page .
