

2020-2021 JOHNSTON HOUSING LOTTERY

March 17th at 4pm in Holt Lobby

1. Select your roommate(s)/suite(s) before lottery day.

- a. Before selecting a room, select AND match with all roommates/suitemates in advance. All students can select/match with any other student and, because all rooms on complex are all-gendered, select any available space/room.
 - Join us for Single Mingle on March 17th at 3:30pm in Holt Lobby before lottery! This is an opportunity to talk with other students looking for roommates.
 - Interested in a single room? No single rooms are a part of the lottery. Should you meet criteria to be considered for a mental/physical housing accommodation, complete the [accommodations process](#) with Academic Success and Disability Services. All remaining singles will be assigned from a waiting list over the summer. The waiting list sign up will be included in your housing confirmation sent via email in April.
- b. Click on *Roommates/Suitemates* under *Housing and Roommate Selection* tab on the MyRedlands Housing Portal.
- c. Search for and select all roommates.
 - Do NOT include students approved to/those who will live off campus, anyone you will not live with, or students studying abroad in the Fall 2020 semester.
- d. Instruct all roommates to visit their own MyRedlands Housing Portal to accept the pending roommate requests.
- e. Review the [Bekins and Holt floor plans](#) to plan ahead what rooms are of most interest, including a variety of back-up options should your top choices be selected. Several of rooms on the floor plan will be reserved for incoming freshman.

2. Review your Johnston Housing Lottery Confirmation email from RLH@redlands.edu

- a. You will receive this email to your Redlands account a few days prior to confirm you are included in the selection process and what time on March 17th you will be granted access to select a room.
- b. Selection times are assigned based on the Johnston community member standing below. Each student has their own individual time, randomly assigned within a standing level, spaced out by 60 seconds each.
 - Rising seniors who have never lived in Bekins and want to
 - Rising seniors who have never lived in Holt and want to
 - All other rising seniors
 - Rising juniors who want to live in Bekins
 - Rising juniors who want to live in Holt
 - Rising sophomores who want to live in Bekins
 - Rising sophomores who want to live in Holt
 - Johnston community members who received their key this academic year, but after move-in
 - Johnston community members who received their key this semester or are planning to transfer in internally.
 - Non-Johnston students who aren't community members, but want to live on complex
- c. Share your lottery time with your roommate and plan to make your room selection during the earliest time collectively assigned in your roommate pairing.

3. Select your room on March 17th at your designated time

- a. Visit the MyRedlands Housing Portal and following the prompts for the Johnston Housing Lottery.
- b. Once a room has been selected and confirmed, you and your roommate will no longer have access to the Johnston Housing Lottery.

4. Review your housing confirmation email

- a. Once your room is selected, an email confirming your selection will be sent to your Redlands account. Should there be an error or concern, reply directly to that message with questions.
- b. Mark your calendar! All returning students may arrive for the Fall 2020 semester on Sunday, September 6th from 8-10AM, 2-5PM, or 8-10PM.
 - Some students will be permitted to move in early (Early Arrival List) for particular reasons and will be given additional specific move-in instructions.
