PRELIMINARY TEACHING CREDENTIAL, SINGLE SUBJECT UNDERGRADUATE MUSIC EDUCATION PROGRAM

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

Students from the College of Arts and Sciences interested in earning a teaching credential must apply to the School of Education. Undergraduate students can enroll in Child Development (EDUG 331) and Educational Foundations (EDUG 401) before the School of Education admission process. Students need to contact an enrollment counselor to discuss the best credential program pathway.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR CREDENTIALS

To be eligible to be recommended for the Preliminary Teaching Credential or the Preliminary Education Specialist Credential, candidates must meet the U.S. Constitution requirement. For details on meeting this requirement, contact the School of Education. **Introduction to American Politics (POLI 111) or American History to 1877 (HIST 121)**, in the College of Arts and Sciences, or their equivalents, satisfy the requirement.

SCHOOL OF EDUCATION ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed application. [Learn more about applying to the School of Education.](#)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- Evidence of negative TB test result within the last 2 years.
- Evidence of Certificate of Clearance.
- Evidence of meeting Basic Skills Requirement.
- Evidence of enrollment in a subject matter competency program. School of Music students are required to request a letter from the Director of the School of Music stating your progress toward the BM in Music Education.
- Evidence of 50 hours of observation or work with children, preferably in a public-school setting or equivalent.
- Completion of Child Development (EDUG 331).
- Two recommendations from professionals who know the applicant's capacity for academic work.
- Admission decisions are made by the Departmental Admissions Committee.

STUDENT TEACHING REQUIREMENTS

Before advancing to student-teaching, students are required to complete the following:

- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above in teacher-prep courses.
- Students must clear all holds.
- Evidence of negative TB test result within the last 2 years.
- Evidence of adult, child, and infant CPR-AED certification.
- Evidence of subject matter competency. School of Music students are required to submit evidence of subject-matter competency via a subject-matter waiver letter issued by the Director of the School of Music.
- Complete an **Advance to Student Teaching Request form** on or before the designated deadline.
