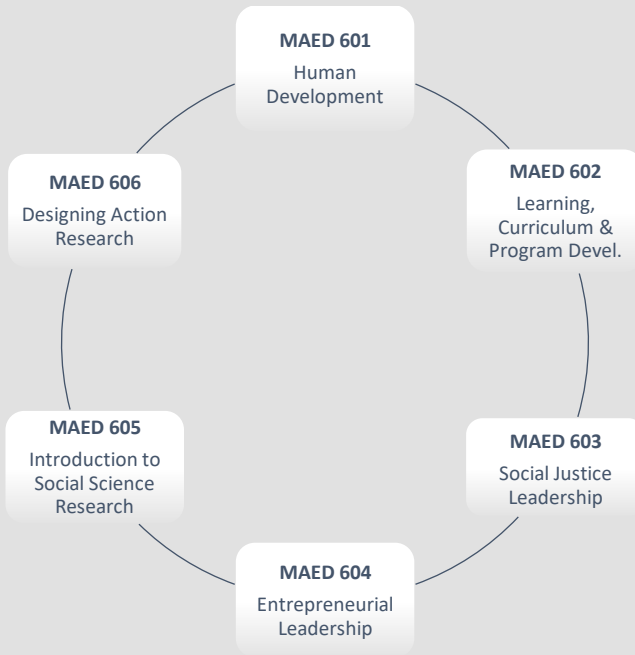

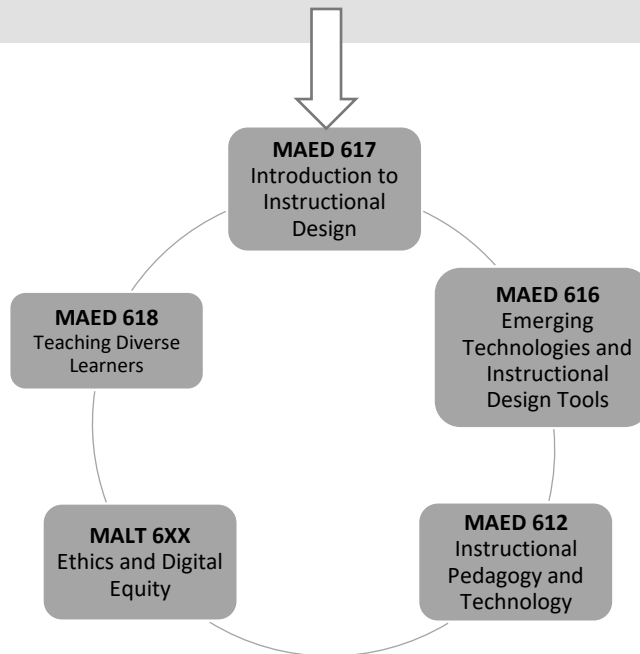

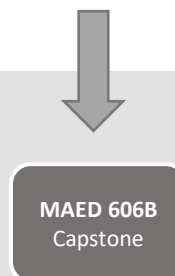
Carousel 1 Foundation
