FIELDWORK AND CULMINATING EXPERIENCES

Fieldwork

Students in the Pre-K-12 track program must complete 800 fieldwork hours. 600 of the 800 hours must be completed in public school settings, in a minimum of two Pre-K-12 levels. The remaining 200 hours of fieldwork may completed in a college or high school-to-college setting. Co-current enrollment in EDUC 677A, B, or C, is required while earning fieldwork hours. Students will work with the Office of Student Success to identify placement sites.

As part of the required fieldwork hours, candidates must complete at least 100 hours of experience in each of the following areas: Social/Emotional, College/Career, and Academic.

Comprehensive Exam

Students must pass the Counselor Preparation Comprehensive Exam (CPCE) in order to complete program requirements. See Handbook for more information.

Commencement Ceremony Participation

School of Education students complete program requirements at various points throughout the year. The Commencement ceremony occurs in April. Students may apply to participate in the academic year in which they complete their program requirements as long as they do so by August 31. Eligible students **must apply** for commencement via Student Planning Portal by January 31. A reasonable plan for completing the remaining requirements by August 31 should also be submitted to the student's advisor by January 31. Learn more
