- <u>CPR Certificate:</u> Recommend to complete during semester 1.
- US Constitution Requirement: Recommend to complete during semester 1.
- <u>RICA Exam:</u> Must be met for Preliminary Credential recommendation. Recommend to complete after meeting subject matter competency.
- <u>CalTPA Cycle 1 and 2:</u> Must be met for Preliminary Credential recommendation. Will be completed during student teaching or internship.

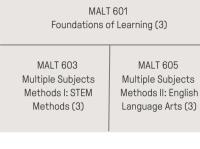

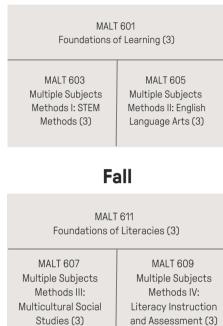
