

### **Student Teaching**

- Students must apply for student teaching by the designated deadline.
- Application includes subject matter competency, CPR, and negative TB test. See all requirements and details on <u>Student Teaching webpage</u>.

#### Internship Eligibility

- Students can apply for eligibility after they have completed 9 credits.
- Application includes subject matter competency and recommendation letters. See all requirements and details on Teaching Internship webpage.

## **ADVISING**

- Open Advising is available. Get support from a Student Success Advisor, no appointment required.
- Schedule an appointment with your Office of Student Success Advisor.
- Group Advising sessions are held each semester with presentations on program updates and requirements. Attendance is highly encouraged.

# PRELIMINARY CREDENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

- <u>Subject Matter Competency:</u> Must be met by the designated student teaching application deadline or after semester 1 for internship eligibility.
- CPR Certificate: Recommend to complete during semester 1.
- <u>US Constitution Requirement:</u> Recommend to complete during semester 1.
- <u>RICA Exam:</u> Must be met for Preliminary Credential recommendation.
   Recommend to complete after meeting subject matter competency.
- <u>CalTPA Cycle 1 and 2</u>: Must be met for Preliminary Credential recommendation. Will be completed during student teaching or internship.
