


2023 Bachelor of Science in Business (BSB) Graduation Survey Summary

Response Rate - BSB

Out of 79 respondents, 24 (30.38%) responded that they are pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Business.

Modality Information – BSB



The majority of students took courses in the Online Live (synchronous) modality - where students take courses taught remotely so that students can log in and attend class from anywhere while interacting with faculty and online peers in real-time.

Tuition Discounts

Out of the 24 BSB student respondents, 18 (75.00%) indicated that they received some form of tuition discount. Of those who received tuition discounts:

- 1 received an Alumni discount (5.56%)
- 2 received an Employer Partner discount (11.11%)
- 1 received a Student Scholarship (5.56%)
- 3 received Veterans/Military benefits (16.67%)
- 10 received a Community College Pathway discount (55.56%)
- 1 indicated some other form of discount (5.56%)

Contributions to Student Success - BSB Students

Asked about what contributed to their success at the University of Redlands School of Business & Society, BSB students pointed most often to Class Size (100.00%), Schedule of Instruction (91.67%), Administration and Staff (87.50%), and Faculty (87.50%).

Measures of Student Satisfaction - BSB Students

Overall, students were very satisfied with their experience at the School of Business & Society. Students gave high approval ratings (indicating they "Agreed" or "Strongly Agreed" that they were "satisfied with the following experiences") to curriculum (95.83%), education value (95.83%), self-registration in student planning (95.83%), classroom environment (95.83%), and degree program (95.83%). Students indicated higher than 90% approval for 6 of 13 experiences listed.
