FIELDWORK AND CULMINATING EXPERIENCES

Fieldwork

Students on the college-emphasis track must complete 400 fieldwork hours, students complete a minimum of 200 hours in a college setting. The remaining hours can be completed in a college or high school-to-college transition setting. Co-current enrollment in EDUC 677 is required while earning fieldwork hours. Students will work with the Office of Student Success to identify placement sites.

Comprehensive Exam

Students must pass the <u>Counselor Preparation</u>
<u>Comprehensive Exam (CPCE)</u>, with a score of 72 points or higher, in order to complete program requirements.

Commencement Ceremony Participation

School of Education students complete program requirements at various points throughout the year. The Commencement ceremony occurs in April. Students may apply to participate in the academic year in which they complete their program requirements as long as they do so by August 31. Eligible students **must apply** for commencement via Student Planning Portal by January 31. A reasonable plan for completing the remaining requirements by August 31 should also be submitted to the student's advisor by January 31. Learn more
